Alexander the Great defeats the Persians at the Battle of Issus. He dies in ___ at the age of 32 and his kingdom is divided among his four generals.

General _____ takes control of Egypt & Palestine while General _____ takes control of Syria and the lands to its east.

Seleucid King Antiochus III, with the help of the Jews, conquers Palestine from the Ptolemaic Kingdom.

Antiochus IV (a.k.a. Antiochus Epiphanes) becomes king. In 171, he begins _____ days of Jewish persecution, which included the defilement of the Temple in Dec ____ and continued until his death in 164. (See Dan 8:9-14, 23-25 & 11:21-35.)

Maccabean Revolt begins.

Judas Maccabeus gains control of Jerusalem & re-purifies the Temple thereby re-establishing Jewish Temple worship. _____ (a.k.a. Feast of _____) is established.
