## Lesson 7 – Psalm 23:3b "He Leadeth Me in the Paths of Righteousness for His Name's Sake" – Part 2

Why does He restoreth our souls? So that He can leadeth us in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

## 1. "in the *paths* of righteousness":

- a. In the Hebrew Bible = "*ma gal*" = a \_\_\_\_\_ path.
- b. In the LXX =  $\tau \rho i \beta o \upsilon \varsigma$  = Fem, Pl, Acc of  $\tau \rho i \beta o \varsigma$ :
  - 1) "of a \_\_\_\_\_ that is \_\_\_\_\_ and well-worn" BDAG.
  - 2) fig. = "of established \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_" BDAG.
  - 3) Only used 3x in NT and all concerning the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of John the Baptist:
    - a) "The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his \_\_\_\_\_\_ straight (straight forward, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_, sincere)" (Matt 3:3, Mark 1:3, Luke 3:4).
    - b) Remember the Lord's testimony concerning John the Baptist?

"For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a \_\_\_\_\_\_ than John the Baptist" (Luke 7:28).

  - e) **Prov 13:15** "...the way of transgressors is \_\_\_\_\_."
  - f) **Prov 16:20** "...and whoso trusteth in the LORD, \_\_\_\_\_ is he."
  - g) *Read* Ps 37:23-25.
- 2) For His \_\_\_\_:
