# Lesson 15 – Revelation 8:1-13 The \_\_\_\_\_ Tribulation \_\_\_\_\_

### 1. The Seventh Seal is Opened (v1):

- a. This marks the beginning of the second 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years of the seven year tribulation referred to by Jesus in Matt 24:21 as the "\_\_\_\_\_\_\_."
- b. The Seventh Seal constitutes \_\_\_\_\_ judgments to come throughout the \_\_\_\_\_\_ second 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years of the tribulation. In other words, the Trumpet Judgments do not \_\_\_\_\_\_ the Seventh Seal; they \_\_\_\_\_ the Seventh Seal.

#### 2. Introduction to the Trumpet Judgments (v2-6):

- a. Who is the "another angel," i.e., the \_\_\_\_\_ angel?
  - 1) Option 1: An angel (i.e., a \_\_\_\_\_\_ spiritual being) designated for this work in heaven.
  - Option 2: The Angel of \_\_\_\_\_\_ (e.g., Gen 16:7, Ex 3:2, Num 22:22, Judg 2:1, 1 Kgs 19:7, Isa 37:36), i.e., the Lord \_\_\_\_\_\_.
    - a) \_\_\_\_\_ in His current ministry as \_\_\_\_\_ (v3-4).

# 3. The First Trumpet Judgment (v7): \_\_\_\_\_ Smitten

- a. Its immediate impact:
  - 1) 1/3 of all \_\_\_\_\_ burned up.
  - 2) 1/3 of all green \_\_\_\_\_ burned up.
  - 3) Copious amounts of \_\_\_\_\_\_ from both man and beast.
- b. Its parallel: *read* Ex 9:18-26.
- c. Its longer term impact:
  - 1) Destruction of \_\_\_\_\_, which leads to famine and unrest.
  - 2) Loss of \_\_\_\_\_\_ for herbivores, which adds to the famine and unrest.
  - 3) \_\_\_\_\_ changes due to increases in carbon dioxide and decreases in oxygen.
  - 4) Massive \_\_\_\_\_ slides.

# 4. The Second Trumpet Judgment (v8-9): \_\_\_\_\_ Smitten

- a. Its immediate impact:
  - 1) 1/3 of \_\_\_\_\_ (probably those nearest the impact) become blood.
  - 2) 1/3 of sea \_\_\_\_\_ (probably those nearest the impact) dies.
  - 3) 1/3 of world's \_\_\_\_\_ (and assumingly the \_\_\_\_\_ on them) destroyed (probably those nearest the impact).
- b. Its parallel: *read* Ex 7:14-24.
- c. Its longer term impact:
  - 1) Destruction and death caused by the \_\_\_\_\_ created by the impact.
  - 2) Severe \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the distribution of critically needed supplies and materials.
  - 3) Major \_\_\_\_\_\_ in world power due to the loss of significant numbers of naval assets.
  - 4) Famine, starvation, and death especially in those areas closest to the impact. People living on \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the affected area would be hit the hardest.

# 5. The Third Trumpet Judgment (v10-11): \_\_\_\_\_ Smitten

- a. Its immediate impact:
  - 1) 1/3 of all \_\_\_\_\_\_ sources contaminated (i.e., poisoned).
  - 2) Many perish from \_\_\_\_\_\_ the poisoned water.
- b. Its parallel (or better here its contrast): *read* Ex 15:23-27.
  - 1) In Exodus 15, God makes that which is \_\_\_\_\_ for those who \_\_\_\_\_ Him.
  - In Revelation 8, God makes that which is \_\_\_\_\_\_ for those who do not \_\_\_\_\_\_ Him.
- c. Its longer term impact:
  - 1) Many more deaths resulting from \_\_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2) Societal \_\_\_\_\_ resulting from the shortage of drinkable water.

### 6. The Fourth Trumpet Judgment (v12): \_\_\_\_\_ Smitten

- a. Its immediate impact:
  - 1) Daylight hours are reduced by \_\_\_\_\_.
  - 2) Moonlight and starlight hours are reduced by \_\_\_\_\_.
  - 3) Four hours of the normal day and four hours of the normal night are now in \_\_\_\_\_
- b. Its parallel:
  - 1) *Read* Ex 10:21-23 The Egyptian \_\_\_\_\_ god (Amun-Re) was thought to be personified in the person of the pharaoh.
  - 2) *Read* Ex 11:4-6 The Egyptian \_\_\_\_\_ god (Amun-Khonsu) was thought to be personified in the person of the pharaoh's firstborn son.

- c. Its longer term impact:
  - 1) Production of \_\_\_\_\_\_ severely hampered due to less \_\_\_\_\_\_ time.
  - 2) \_\_\_\_\_ changes due to the decrease in the hours of solar \_\_\_\_\_.
  - 3) Difficulties in nighttime \_\_\_\_\_\_ due to the absence of light from key or critical \_\_\_\_\_\_ stars (e.g., the North Star and the Southern Cross).

### 7. The Overall Impact of the First Four Trumpets:

- a. "\_\_\_\_\_ is destroyed; \_\_\_\_\_\_ is crippled; \_\_\_\_\_ supply is limited; \_\_\_\_\_\_ is hampered" (Walvoord, pg 156 where he is quoting J. B. Smith).
- b. According to the triple \_\_\_\_\_ pronouncement that concludes this chapter, it is only going to get \_\_\_\_\_ (v13).
- c. "Though it is difficult in this day of \_\_\_\_\_\_ to imagine such catastrophic judgments, the Word of God is plain, and men are called everywhere to avail themselves of \_\_\_\_\_\_ before it is too late" (Walvoord, pg 157).
