

**Lesson 20 – Revelation 11:1-14**  
**The Two \_\_\_\_\_: Part 2**

**5. The \_\_\_\_\_ (v5-6):**

a. The powers given:

- 1) Compare v5 to 2 Kgs 1:9-12 and 1 Kgs 18:37-38.
- 2) Compare the “power to shut heaven” to 1 Kgs 17:1 (which according to Luke 4:25 and James 5:17, lasted for 3 ½ years).
- 3) Compare the “power over waters to turn them to blood” to Ex 4:1-9.
- 4) Compare the “power ... to smite the earth with all plagues” to Ex 7-12.

b. The purpose of the powers given:

- 1) The example of Elijah in 1 Kgs 18:17-40:
  - a) To \_\_\_\_\_ his ministry – see v36.
  - b) To \_\_\_\_\_ his actions – see v 36.
  - c) To \_\_\_\_\_ the people to choose who the one and only true God is – see v37-39.
  - d) To \_\_\_\_\_ what happens to those whom choose wrongly – see v40.
- 2) The example of Moses in Ex 4:1-9:
  - a) So that his people would \_\_\_\_\_ (i.e., give \_\_\_\_\_) to his message – see Ex 3:18.
  - b) So that his people would \_\_\_\_\_ forces with him against the enemy – see Ex 3:18.
- 3) The example of Moses in Ex 7-12:
  - a) To \_\_\_\_\_ His people from bondage – see Ex 7:4.
  - b) To \_\_\_\_\_ His divine majesty and sovereignty to the Egyptians (i.e., the Gentile Nations).

**6. The \_\_\_\_\_?**

a. Option 1: \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_:

- 1) Because the powers and signs given to them so closely \_\_\_\_\_ those in verses 5-6.

2) Because these two were also present at the \_\_\_\_\_ – see Matt 17:1-8.

b. Option 2: \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_:

1) Because \_\_\_\_\_ 9:27 can't be violated.

2) Because the combined testimony of these two seems more \_\_\_\_\_ to this situation than does the combined testimonies of the other two.

a) \_\_\_\_\_ represents the \_\_\_\_\_, which is why God chose to give him the punishment that He gave him for his indiscretions in the desert – see Num 20:8-12.

b) \_\_\_\_\_ testimony:

1] He walked by \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb 11:6) because “before his translation he had this testimony, that he \_\_\_\_\_ God” (Heb 11:5).

2] “And \_\_\_\_\_ also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord \_\_\_\_\_ with ten thousands of his saints, To execute \_\_\_\_\_ upon all, and to \_\_\_\_\_ all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed” (Jude 14-15).

#### 7. Their \_\_\_\_\_ (v7-10):

a. Lesson 1 (v7): God's faithful witness is \_\_\_\_\_ until he \_\_\_\_\_ the task that he was sent to do.

b. Lesson 2 (v8-10): God \_\_\_\_\_ this grotesque spectacle to take place so that we can see the \_\_\_\_\_ He places on how \_\_\_\_\_ they were in \_\_\_\_\_ their assigned task.

#### 8. Their New \_\_\_\_\_ (v11-12):

- d. It serves to remind us that the devil will be permitted to win some \_\_\_\_\_, but Christ will win the \_\_\_\_\_. So, it is not \_\_\_\_\_ whom we die that is important, but rather, \_\_\_\_\_ whom and \_\_\_\_\_ whom we die that matters!
- e. It also serves as a stark reminder that their god can only \_\_\_\_\_ life; whereas, the true God, whom they are rejecting, is both the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of life!

**9. The Conclusion of the \_\_\_\_\_ Woe (v13-14):**

- a. v13: "the \_\_\_\_\_ part" – This earthquake and the property damage it causes serves like a seal to the \_\_\_\_\_ provided by the two witnesses.
- b. v13: "were slain of men \_\_\_\_\_ thousand" – This serves as a token of the \_\_\_\_\_ of God's judgment that is about to take place, which is also great cause for His children to \_\_\_\_\_ Him.
- c. v14: The \_\_\_\_\_ Trumpet Judgment plus this \_\_\_\_\_ with its resulting death and destruction constitute the \_\_\_\_\_ Woe.
