2. The Bread of Life: First of Seven “I am the ...” Statements!

**a. Review of the First Nine Characteristics:**

- 1) v27: The first characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life is not of this world.
- 2) v28-29: The second characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life is belief in the Son of Man.
- 3) v30-33: The third characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life is God the Father.
- 4) v34-36: The fourth characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life is to prevent us from ever being spiritually or physically hungry or thirsty.
- 5) v37: The fifth characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life vary.
- 6) v38-40: The sixth characteristic is that \_\_\_\_\_ of the bread of life never expires.
