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- d. Can a person be saved without being an actual disciple? Can a person be a believer in or follower of Christ without being willing to comply with the requirements of a disciple as laid out by Jesus above?
  - 1) By definition a disciple of Christ is a follower of or believer in Christ, so how can a person be saved by Christ without being a follower of Christ?
